The Fourth Term of the Emerging Leaders in Philanthropy Program Ended

TUSEV has been implementing the Emerging Leaders in Philanthropy Program under Philanthropy Infrastructure Development in Turkey Project with an aim to enhance the dialogue among professionals working in areas related to philanthropy. In the fourth term of the program, ended in June 2017, various aspects of philanthropy such as individual giving, corporate philanthropy, grantmaking, donor relations and donor management, communication and campaigning, legal and fiscal framework binding civil society, and new models of giving based on international knowledge were covered.

Artists Announced for the 15th Istanbul Biennial



project will be used to provide special education and rehabilitation for children with Cerebral Palsy free of charge. In Steptember, participants within teams of four will take 10.000 steps daily and collect donations by mobilizing their networks. In the last three years 1.784 free education and rehabilitation sessions for 487 children with Cerebral Palsy were made thanks to the donations collected by 4.310 volunteers of which 129 are corporate volunteers. A solar power plant has been put into operation at the Koç School with the aim of capitalizing on renewable energy sources, turning it into an educational opportunity and creating a learning environment, as well as raising awareness of this topic. The power plant, which will meet 35% of the school's electricity requirement, has the highest installed capacity for a plant built in an educational institution in Turkey, and also the largest installed power in the Marmara Region. Right next to the solar power plant there is the "Solar House", designed for the students to work on several topics and renewable energy resources in particular, and develop projects.
