New Report from the UN Special Rapporteur

United Nations Special

Rapporteur on the rights to freedom of peaceful assembly and of association Maina Kiai presented the report "Comparing States" Treatment of Businesses and Associations Worldwide" to UN General Assembly on October 27. The Report compares the enabling environments that states, multilateral organizations and other actors create for businesses and associations, and highlights instances where they are treated equally. According to Kiai, states would better promote and protect the rights of freedom of peaceful assembly and of association if they elevated their treatment of associations to similar levels as their treatment
